HUNDRED DOLLARS, WAS TAKEN FROM THE POSSESSION OF ZELLA HOLDER BY



ON 04/05/2016 I RECEIVED A CALL FROM ZELLA HOLDER WHO STATES RONALD HENRY CAME ONTO HER PROPERTY, CUT HER WIRE AND BAILE HAY WITHOUT PERMISSION, SHE ALSO STATES THAT MR HENRY TOOK THE HAY WITHOUT HER PERMISSION, WHEN SHE MADE CONTACT WITH MR.HENRY HE STATED HE HAD JUST MADE A MISTAKE, HE WOULD JUST GIVE BACK THE HAY. HE ALREADY HAD THE HAY LOADED ON A TRAILER. MR HENRY TOOK THE HAY WITH HIM WHEN HE LEFT.

MRS HOLDER ALSO STATES MR HENRY CONTINUED TO TRESPASS ON HER PROPERTY, SHE STATES SHE BEGAN FENCING THE PERIMETER OF HER PROPERTY AND POSTING NO TRESPASSING SIGNS. SHE STATES " I HAVE T POST ON ALL OF THE SURVEY POINTS THAT HAVE BEEN KNOWN BOUNDRIES TO ALL. I HAVE HAD A CONTINOUS TRESSPASSING PROBLEM WITH RONALD HENRY THIS HAS BEEN GOING ON SINCE APRIL 1992. WHEN I PURCHASED THE PROPERTY, HENRY HAD ASSUMED THAT THIS WAS OWNED BY HIS AUNTIE ONLY A SMALL PORTION WAS ALL SHE OWEN. §26-16-105. Fraud.

A. Any person who knowingly perpetrates fraud, or who steals supplies used to conduct an election, in order to change a voter's vote, or to change the composition of the official ballot or ballots, or to change the counting of the ballots, or to change the certification of the results of an election, shall be deemed guilty of a felony.

B. At every precinct there shall be posted information, provided by the State Election Board, which states the penalties for voter fraud and states that, if voter fraud is suspected, complaints should be reported to the State Election Board.

C. The State Election Board shall, upon receiving the complaint:

- 1. Document such complaint and request the name and mailing address of the person making the complaint;*
- 2. Send a letter to the person making the complaint, stating the penalties for voter fraud and the option of contacting the district attorney in the county where such fraud is suspected; and*
- 3. Provide the district attorney's name and phone number.*

D. All information relating to voter complaints shall remain confidential until after the complaint has resulted in a conviction or a plea of guilty or nolo contendere.

I, Gary Eastridge, being first duly sworn upon oath, depose and state as follows:

Your Affiant is a peace/police officer employed as the Chief Investigator by the Oklahoma County District Attorney's Office. I was first certified as a police officer in 1979. Since that time I have had training and experience in many aspects of criminal investigation. My employment responsibilities as Chief Investigator include investigation of suspected criminal conduct in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma. Your Affiant has learned through the investigation set forth herein as follows:

In July of 2015 the Oklahoma County District attorney's office received a call alleging voter fraud in the Luther City Board Trustee election held in April of 2015. The

allegation was that Candidate Ronald Henry conspired with members of his family to fraudulently use absentee ballots to gain votes.

Oklahoma County District Attorneys investigators reviewed absentee ballots and their supporting documents and interviewed many of those absentee voters. Candidate Ronald Henry was interviewed as was Luther Board Trustee Cecilia Taft who notarized many of the absentee ballot affidavits. The investigation revealed the following:

On or about March 25th of 2015 Cecilia Taft received a call from either Mr. or Mrs. Henry (she could not recall which) asking if she could notarize a few absentee ballots. Ms. Taft agreed to do so. Cecilia Taft advised that on March 25th 2015 one of Ronald Henry's granddaughters's brought 4 absentee ballots to Taft's home to be notarized. The ballots were for Brittany LaShawn Henry, Theodoye Quinton Goosby, Bonitta Marie Prince and Charles Wesley Prince. Ms. Taft admitted she notarized the four ballots without the individuals being present and identifying themselves as prescribed by law. Theodoye Goosby was interviewed and advised he did not fill out an absentee ballot and did not vote in the election. The Princes were interviewed and advised they have not lived in Luther for 2-3 years. They claimed they took the ballots to Ms. McCauley (thought to be Taft) to be notarized.

Cecilia Taft advised that on March 27th 2015 Brenda Henry brought four absentee ballots to Ms. Taft's residence to notarize. They were in the name Mandrale Alexander Henry, Patricia G. Henry, Jonathon S. Henry and Bryan K. Henry. Ms. Taft admitted she notarized the ballots without the persons being present. Mandrale Henry was interviewed and advised he filled out his absentee ballot and took it to "a guy" who notarized it in OKC. The affidavit is notarized by Cecilia Taft. Patricia Henry claimed that she filled out her ballot and personally took it to Ms. Taft to be notarized. It should be noted that Patricia Henry's name is spelled Patricia G. Henry on the Application for Absentee Ballots yet is misspelled on the Affidavit for the absentee ballot. The Affidavit shows the spelling of "Patricia" as PATRICA at two separate locations on the Affidavit which was notarized by Ms. Taft.

Cecilia Taft advised that on April 3rd Ronald Henry brought an absentee ballot for Kelly Shea Hill to Ms. Taft's home for her to notarize. Ms. Taft advised she knows that Ms. Hill is the ex-girlfriend of Ronald Henry Jr. Ms. Taft notarized the absentee ballot in the name of Kelly Shea Hill without Ms. Hill being present.

Summary

The investigation has revealed that both Ronald and Brenda Henry submitted Oklahoma Absentee Ballots to Cecilia Taft to be notarized for the April 7, 2015 Luther City Board election. The investigation revealed and Ms. Taft admitted, that on 3-25-2015, 3-27-2015 and 4-3-2015 she notarized absentee ballot affidavits without the person being present whose name is on the affidavit of an absent voter.

The Aforementioned acts occurred in Luther, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma and constitute a violation of Title 26 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 16, 105 which is a felony.
